**john Vincent** both days **alongside "spooky" exhibition**  
painting without brushes - improve creative thinking by painting with alternatives whilst working collaboratively on a large canvas, divided in to a grid with images based on the firebird

**fashion**

help produce a fire and flight themed garment using mixed materials and your own imagination

**printmaking**

make monotype transfer prints to create black and white and colour illustrations for the Firebird Story which will be incorporated in a final art piece (which may be a book)

**drawing**

use different drawing materials and techniques to create your own firebird

working from direct observation, looking at different birds, creating your own magical bird

**smoke firing**

take fired clay books and embellish with smoke and wire from a bin full of sawdust

which will then be set alight to at the end of the workshop

create your own stories for the inside of the books with handmade paper and artists materials

sunday 1<sup>st</sup> november

**amy wilson** 10.00-13.00

**weaving**

weave fabrics inspired by the firebird using a variety of textured & brightly coloured materials and then make these into a theatrical fascinator

**cathy smale** 13.30-16.30

**painting**

collaborative image of the firebird, use paint, pattern and collage to create feathers and flames

**lizzie lane** 13.30-16.30

**wire sculpture**

explore ways to create different textures and patterns out of wire, which will be used to 'decorate' a wire structure of the fire bird within the story
